What is a Match Play golf event?

Match Play Format of Play is represented by SIDES.....one player vs. one player.....or one team vs. one team. They are referred to as opponents. Scoring is on a hole-by-hole basis. If one side wins a hole.....that side is 1 up.....and the other side is 1 down.

Match #1 (see brackets below) – Jones vs. Smith:

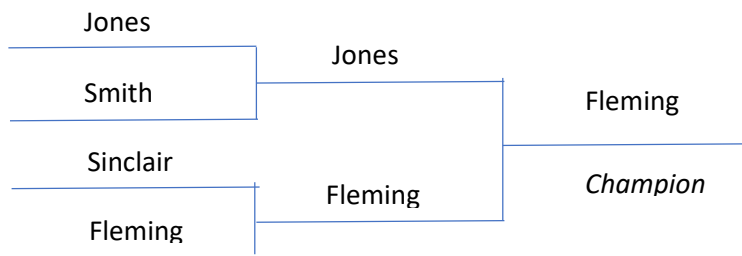
| Hole # | 1 | 2 | 3 | 4 | 5 | 6 | 7 | 8 | 9 | |

| Jones | 4 | 5 | 6 | 3 | 8 | 5 | 5 | 6 | 4 | (Jones wins 1 up) |
| Smith | 5 | 5 | 5 | 4 | 4 | 5 | 6 | 6 | 5 | |

In a Match Play tournament.....players or teams (sides) are placed in brackets.....much like the NCAA National Championship in basketball.

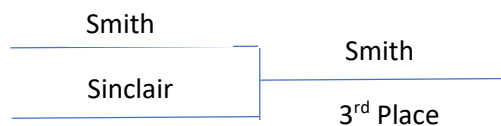
Winners advance to the right.....while non-winners advance to the Consolation Bracket.
