Spectator Carts Permitted

Spectator Carts, as available, may be rented from the IRGF logo tent. Spectator Carts must either remain on cart paths or rough areas. Spectators (walking or in carts) must remain at least 30 yards (short pitch shot) from players. **Spectator Cart Fees payable at IRGF logo tent:** \$15/18 Holes \$10/9 or 6 Holes

Player Assistance – 9 & 6 Hole Players

Player Assistance Carts (allowed) are permitted for 9 & 6 Hole Players. Golf Bags RIDE.....players WALK.

Cart Fees payable at IRGF logo tent: \$15/18 Holes \$10/9 or 6 Holes

Inclement Weather:

In the event of inclement weather, the tournament will be reduced from the number of holes originally planned. In this event, scores will be counted for the number of holes all players in a division have played. Unless event is cancelled in advance - all players are to show-up - as there MAY be a delay in the start times.

A **Notice to Competitors** outlining all details of the event will be distributed in advance by email to all participants. A **Local Rules Sheet** will be listed on the back of the Notice to Competitors.
