## Founder's Cup Celebration Dinner

In addition, each facility should promote the opportunity to reserve a table of eight for members/patrons under the name of the facility itself.

The IRGF strongly feels each Indian River County-based golf facility should support every Founder's Cup Celebration Dinner and Community Golf Tournament, as their own club will be featured one day too. Therefore, it would value solid participation.

Members of the IRGF Player's Club (youth golf participants) see these golf courses, along with their respective staff members on an infrequent basis. The Founder's Cup Celebration Dinner not only recognizes golf facilities' founder(s), but also honors those who give back to the game through the Service Award. It is very meaningful for IRGF youth players to see how local area golf facilities professional management staff members are recognized by being personal guests of their own golf facility on an annual basis. The IRGF reserves two tables of eight and extends invitations to outstanding IRGF youth so that they can participate in these special evenings.
