The PGA Junior League Golf – Spring Series (April – May) - 5 events - is one of two former IRGF and TCJGT joint golf events now converted to PGA Junior League Golf. The other one is PGA Junior League Golf – Summer Series (June – July) – 8 events

The combined Spring & Summer Series advances to Post Season ALL STAR Competitions

Each Series is designed to better socialize the game of golf for all players of all abilities in FUN competitions. Each program features a **TEAM Scramble** format of play. It is a great way to get players of all ages and abilities involved in the game. Parents are spectators. Exception: Some parents may be asked to serve as scorers and coaches for the less experienced players.

Format of Play

Age Range – 13U + Age Range 17U

- 1) Two-Person TEAM SCRAMBLE – 9 Hole Division – 6 Hole Division
- 2) Pairings by age group and experience level for each event - determined by Tournament Committee
- 3) Tee Times beginning at 3:00 p.m. (to be sent out by email) – may arrive up to 1 hour in advance of your tee time (range ball bar codes available at IRGF Logo PLAYER CHECK-IN table at clubhouse.
- 4) Post Season: An **ALL STAR TEAM** qualifies for advancement after the **SUMMER Series**
