## Sandridge Golf Club - Dunes Course

"The Dunes is one of two excellent public courses at Sandridge Golf Club. This course winds in and around natural inland dunes. The front nine is very tight, while the back nine is more like a links course. Greens and tees are elevated and only four holes have water. The par-5s are less than 530 yards, except for the final hole, which is 568 yards. The par-3s are from 156 to 217 yards. This is a public golf course. Metal spikes are tolerated, but not encouraged."
