



Parent/Grandparent/Spectator Guidelines

....behavioral traits of supportive parents/grandparents

- 1) Remain in the spectator areas away from the practice green/range.
Remain off the fairways.....near or on the greens.....**30 yards from players**.....except for supplying hydration drinks & snacks.
Note #1: For your own safety and to minimize becoming part of a USGA golf ruling - when driving Spectator Carts ahead of play – park cart well away from potential landing areas.
Note #2: Players should be seen as the dominate groups on the golf course – not parents and grandparents.
- 2) Let the coach be the coach.
- 3) Provide only supportive comments to coaches, officials, and athletes of both teams. No derogatory comments including anything related to the condition of the golf course.
- 4) Do not coach your daughter/granddaughter during the contest.
- 5) Do not drink alcohol at practices or contests or come after having a drink of alcohol. Cheer for your team.
Acknowledge good play by members of each team.
- 6) Show interest, enthusiasm, and support for your athlete.
Be supportive/empathetic of ALL athletes.
- 7) Control your emotions. Never show disapproval/disappointment of any shot or score. This includes verbal, facial or body language.
- 8) Help when asked by coaches or officials
Golf carts – Transport players off the golf course due to inclement weather.
Shuttle groups from the green to the next tee when assigned by coaches or officials.
Be helpful in all emergency situations.
- 9) All rulings and scoring shall be between the players and coaches ONLY.
